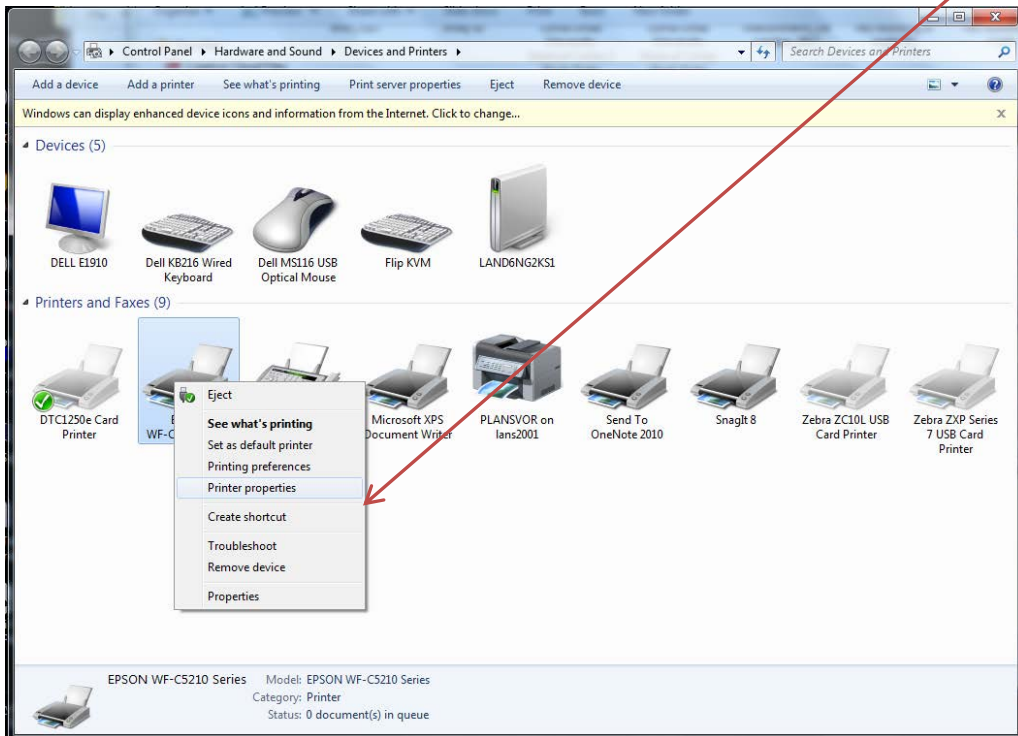




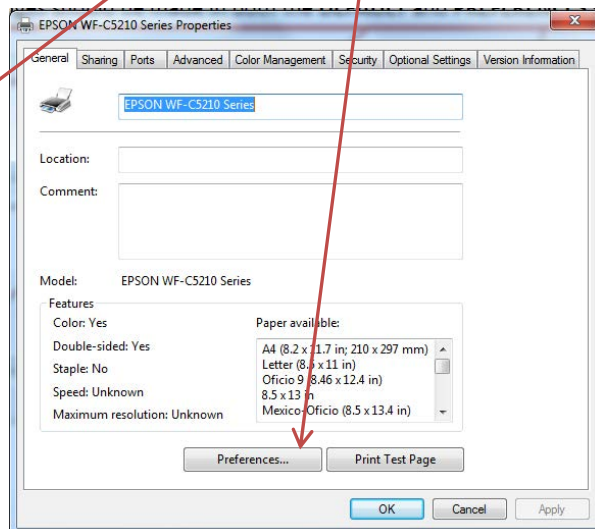
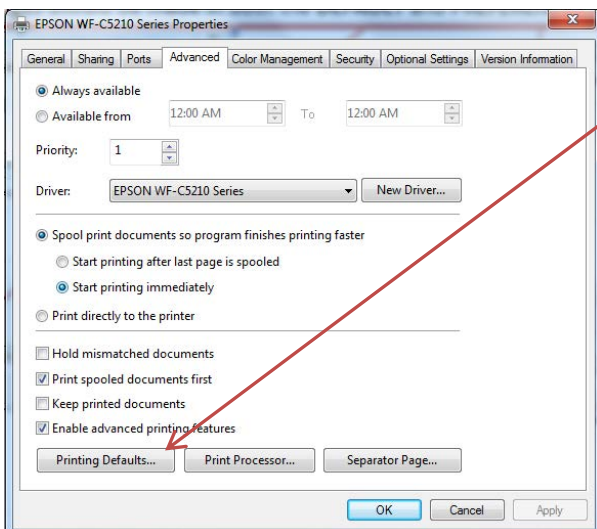
Epson Workforce Pro C5210 Driver Recommendations

Please note that these settings are guidelines and can be adjusted to meet your individual preferences.

Getting Started: When making driver adjustments, be sure to use the "Epson WF-C5210 Series"



Reminder: Driver changes should be made in both the **DEFAULT** and **PREFERENCES** settings.



IMPORTANT: This printer is a center feed printer and requires a custom paper size to be set up. No changes are needed in the ID software.

Step 1: Under the Document Size setting, choose "User-Defined"

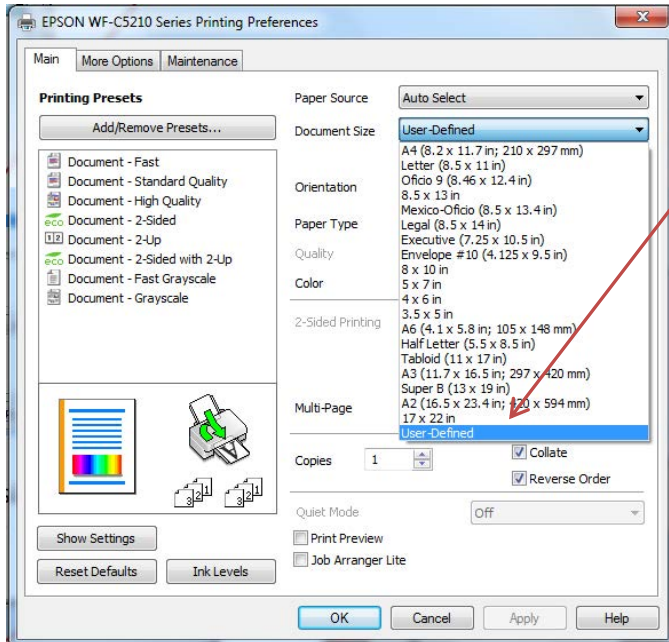
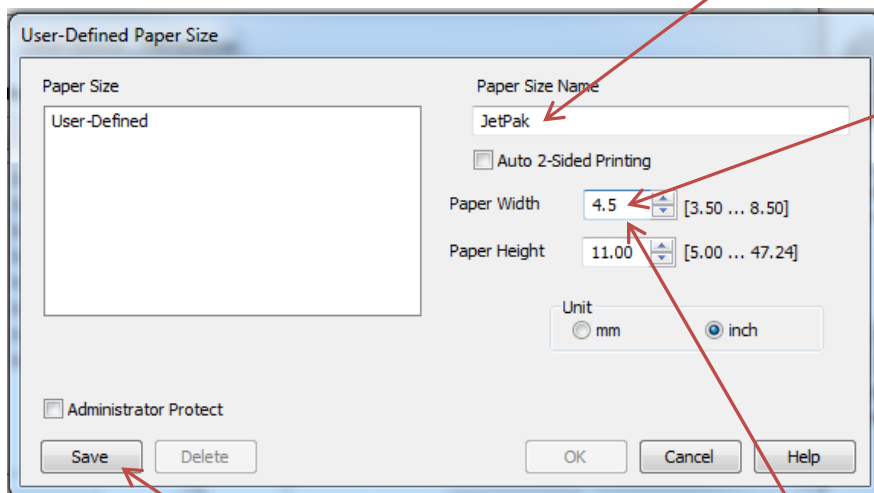


Diagram A. What is the width of my JetPak? To determine the width of your JetPak, simply measure the leading edge of the card stock that is fed into

Step 2: In the pop-up, create a paper size called "JetPak".

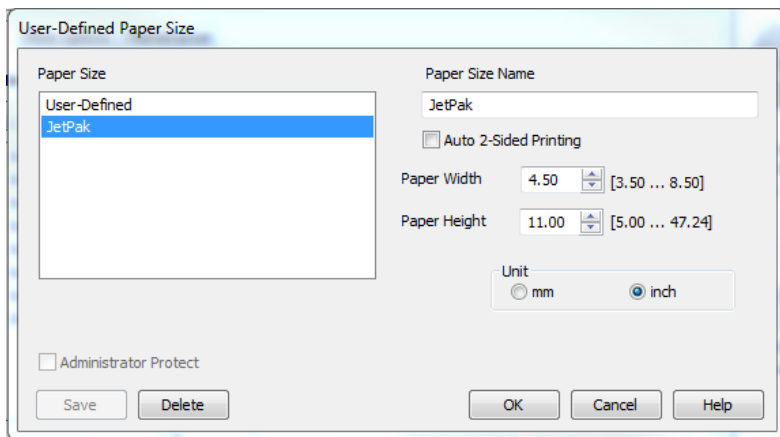
Note: You will need the width of your card stock to complete this task (see diagram A).



Step 3: Place the width of the JetPak in the "Paper Width" box.

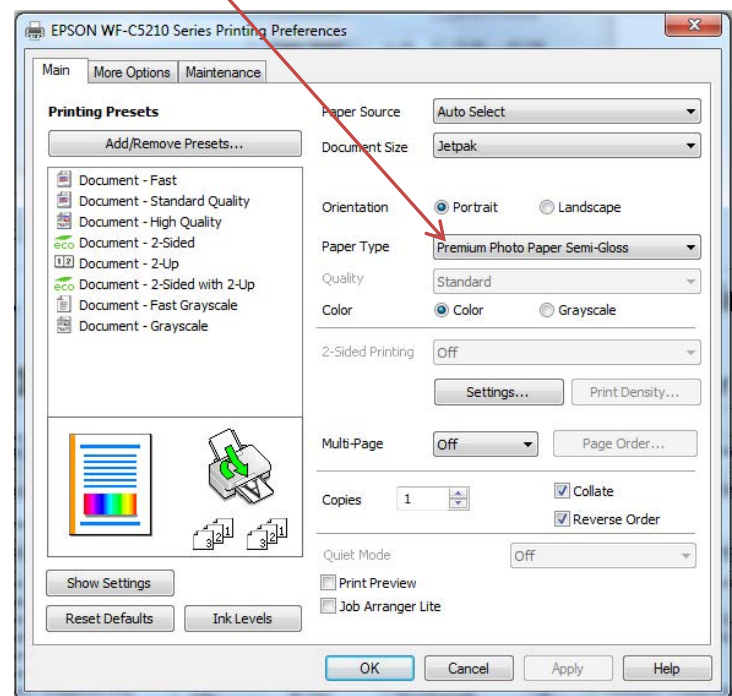
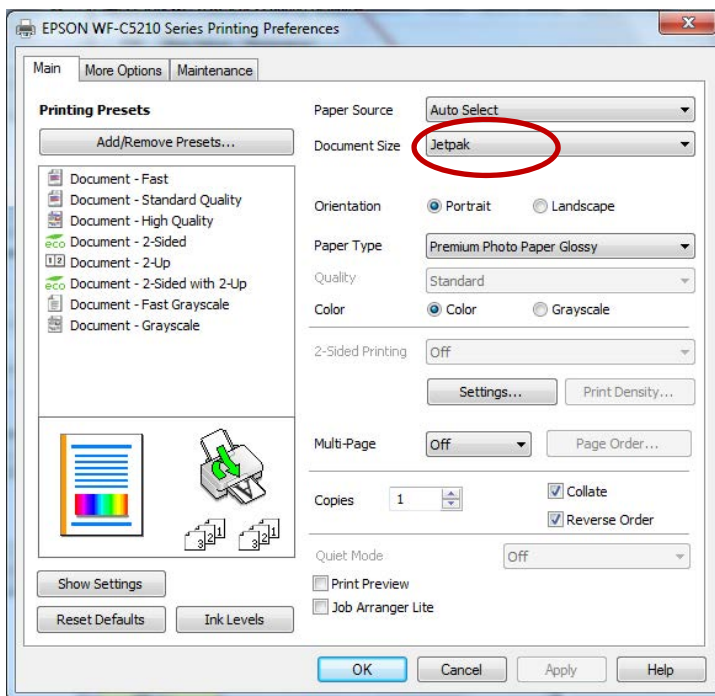
Step 4: Press "Save"

Step 5: The User-Defined Paper Size settings should now look like the image below, press "OK"

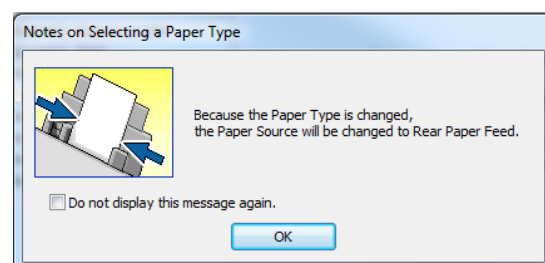


Next, change the Paper Type and Quality settings.

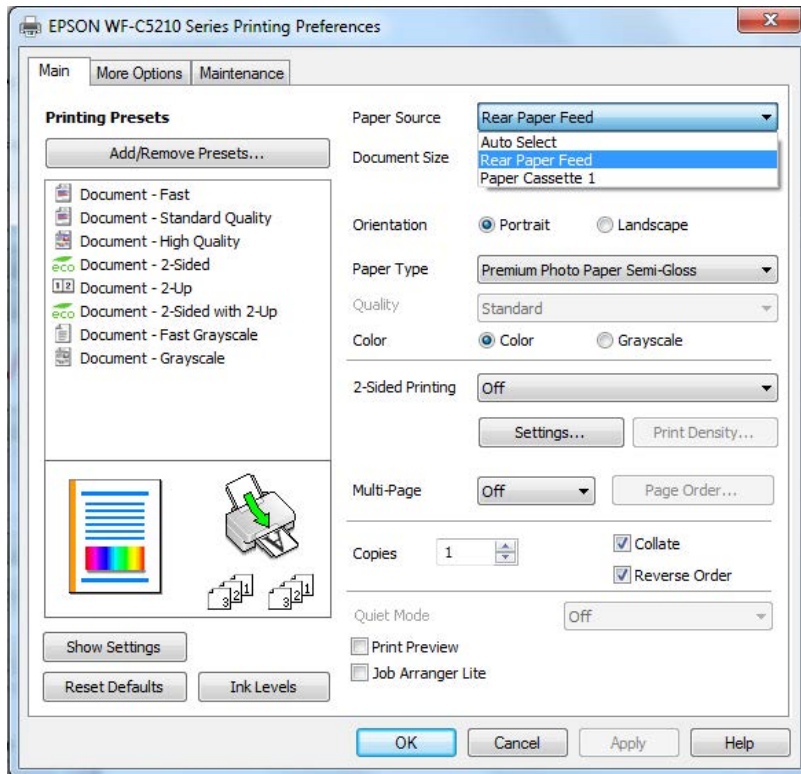
Step 1: Change the Paper Type to "Premium Photo Paper Semi-Gloss"



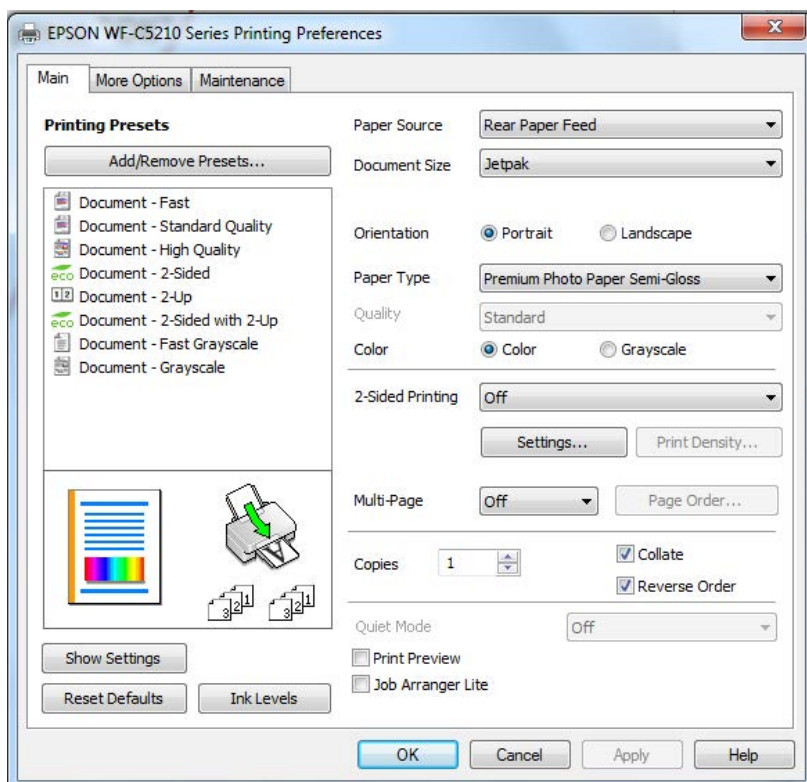
NOTE: If you get this pop-up during this process, simply press "OK"



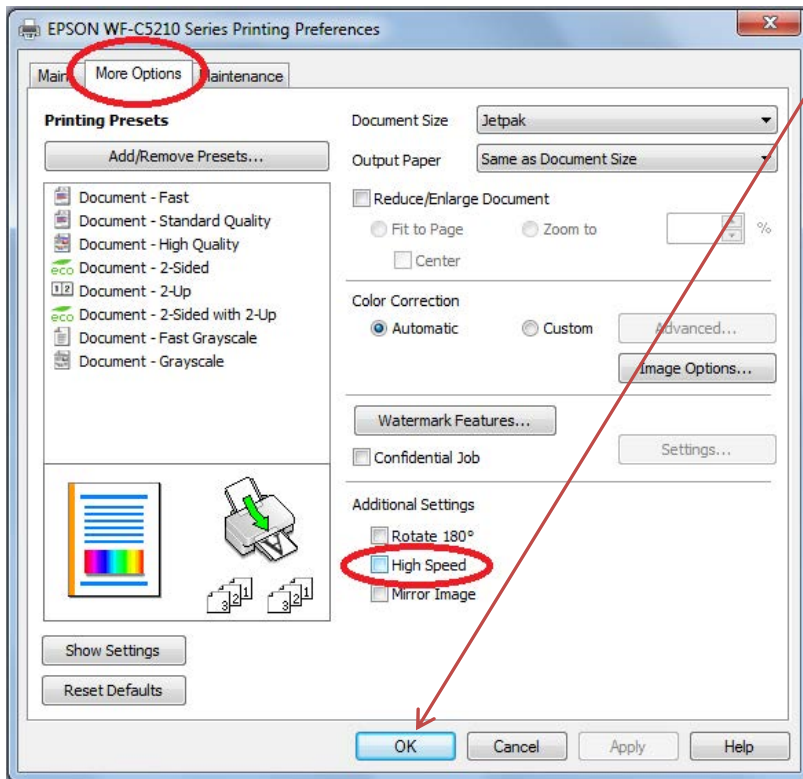
Step 2: Change the Paper Source to "Rear Paper Feed"



Step 3: The settings should look like the tab below



Step 4: Click the "More Options" tab and uncheck the "High Speed" box. Then click "OK"
